Aside from the tv show, Epstein will also produce more movies starring his groups. One movie in particular, "Ferry Across the Mersey," starring Gerry & the Pacemakers and Cilla Black, will be released in this country in another month "I want to do a few dramatic movies, just to show that some of these groups can do more than sing.
